- Fee Schedule-As a village board we all met and updated our fee schedule. We were losing \$10-15 per permit so we needed to raise our prices to at least cover our expenses. The permits are going to be uploaded online so that you can find the correct permit application for which you need. Motion made to accept the fee schedule as typed by Trustee Steinle, seconded by Ziebell. Passed unanimously.

New Business:

- Honor Walk Sponsorship-The village has always done a donation, last month Rich from the Legion asked for the Village to donate. Motion to donate \$500 as we have in the past by Trustee Ziebell, seconded by Trustee Larsen, carried unanimously.
- Commercial Zoning Ordinance-Working on commercial zoning ordinance to be put in place. Currently we do not have any type of commercial ordinance therefore we are working on getting one together for the Village to adopt as soon as possible.
